MES College organises faculty development workshop for BBA teachers

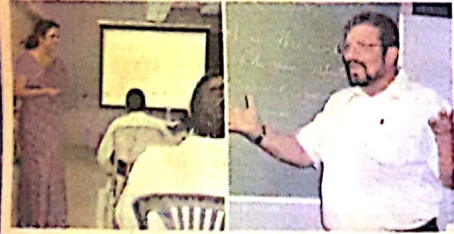

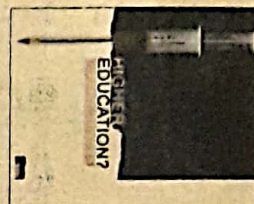

The NSS Unit of MES College of Arts and Commerce, Zuaringar in collaboration with the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) of the Government of India organised a talk for students on the ill effects of drugs and their hazardous impact on youth at the college campus on July 1. Resource person for the talk was Superintendent, Narcotics Control Bureau, Jeelendra Ranjan. The one-hour talk-cum-



presentation was interspersed with images, videos and personal experience of dealing with drug addicts and their families. He discussed types of drugs, symptoms of those under the influence of drugs, economic and psychological costs of drug abuse and statistics of

drug-related deaths. He also provided parents and teachers with a check list to identify drug addicts. Stressing on the importance of identifying young people addicted to drugs and other narcotic substances, Ranjan also said that drugs are equivalent to death. He also emphasized teachers, peer group and parents to watch out for signals of addiction such as behavioral change, lack of interest in usual activities, lower grades, watering of eyes, extensive sleeping hours and being secretive.

A hundred students and six NSS programme officers were present for the awareness talk. Two personnel from the Narcotics Control Bureau, Intelligence Officer, NCB, Vijay Shinde and Constable, NCB, Mohit Senrawat were also present on the occasion.

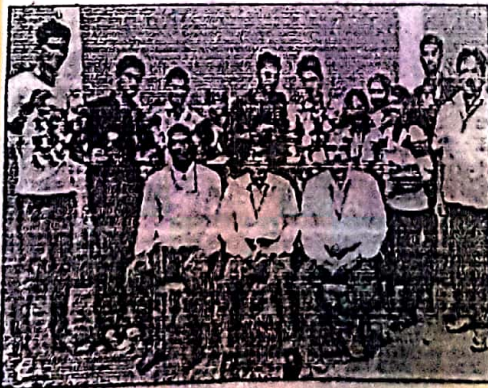
