REPORT ON ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED
From 1st September 2021 till 10th February 2022

1) Orientation Programme for M.Com Part I and Part II Students:

10) CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION:

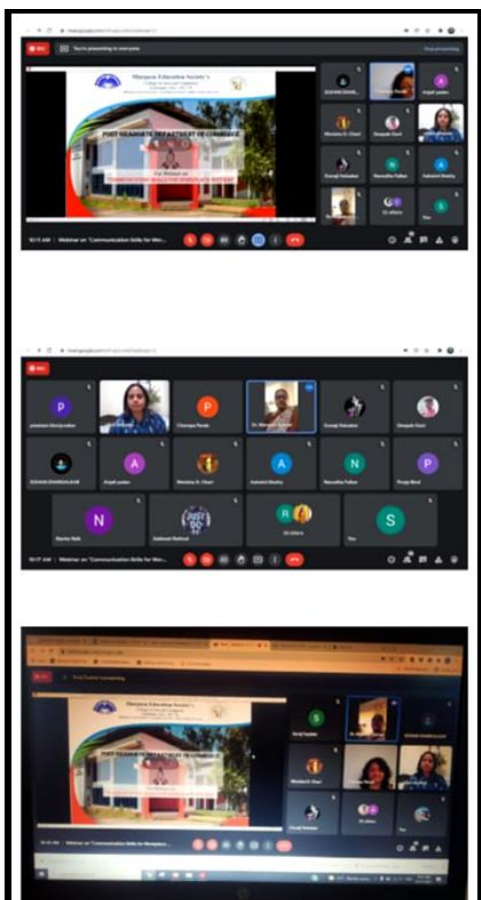

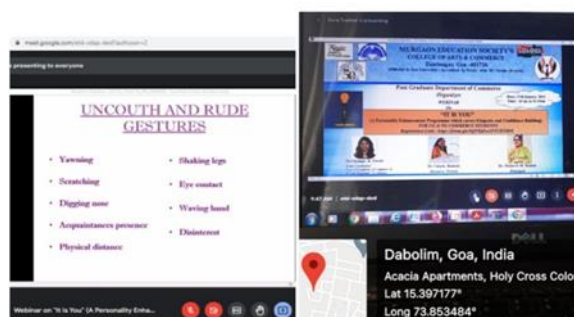
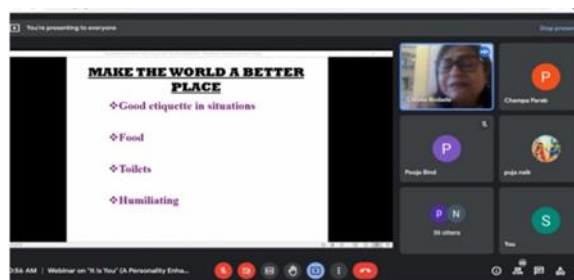
15) E- QUIZ ON “CAPITAL MARKET AND STOCK EXCHANGE OPERATIONS”:

17) SHORT-TERM CERTIFICATE COURSE IN APTITUDE AND REASONING

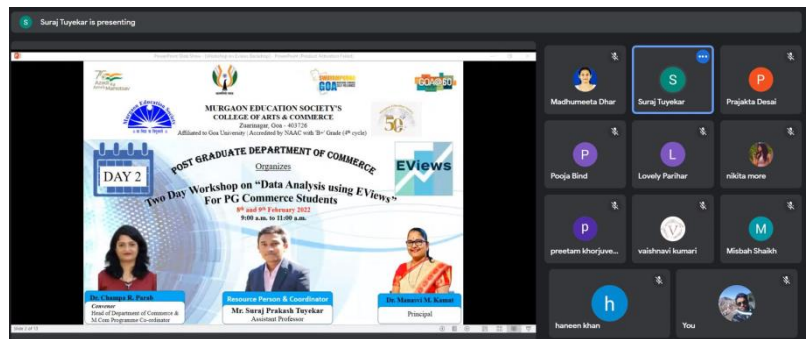
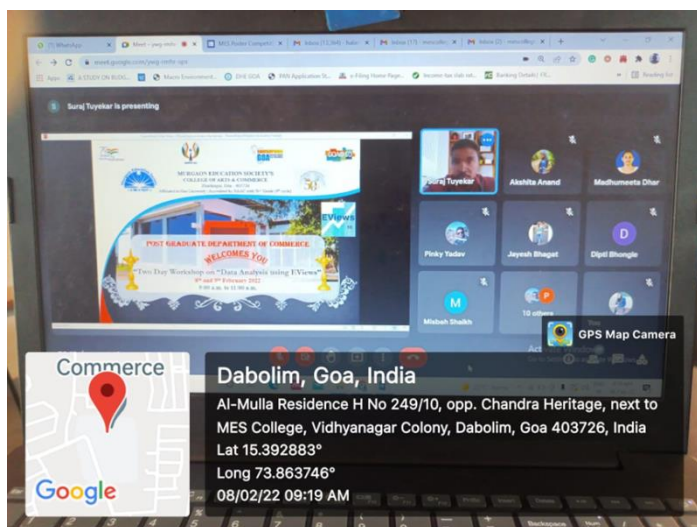
The Post Graduate Department of Commerce of M.E.S College of Arts and Commerce conducted a Thirty hours “Short-term Certificate Course in Aptitude and Reasoning” from 27th November 2021 to 10th February 2022 as a part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and 50 years of Murgaon Education Society. The lectures were conducted thrice a week i.e. on Monday, Tuesday and Saturday from 12:00 p.m. to 2.00 p.m. The course was initially conducted in offline mode (7 Sessions of two hours) and due to Covid lockdown the remaining 08 sessions of two hours were conducted in online mode. The objective of the course was to make the students aware of the fundamental concepts, tricks and methods of aptitude and reasoning for clearing competitive exams. The resource person for the course was Assistant Professor Mr. Pranit Satyavan Naik, faculty from the Post Graduate Department of Commerce of the college. 18 students from M.Com Part-I had registered and successfully completed the course. The course was offered free of cost to the students. The course was inaugurated on 27 November 2021 where Dr. Champa Parab, H.O.D of Commerce and M.Com Programme Co-ordinator welcomed the participants and the Resource Person and introduced the resource person. She also expressed her gratitude to the resource person for coming up with such course which will enable the
