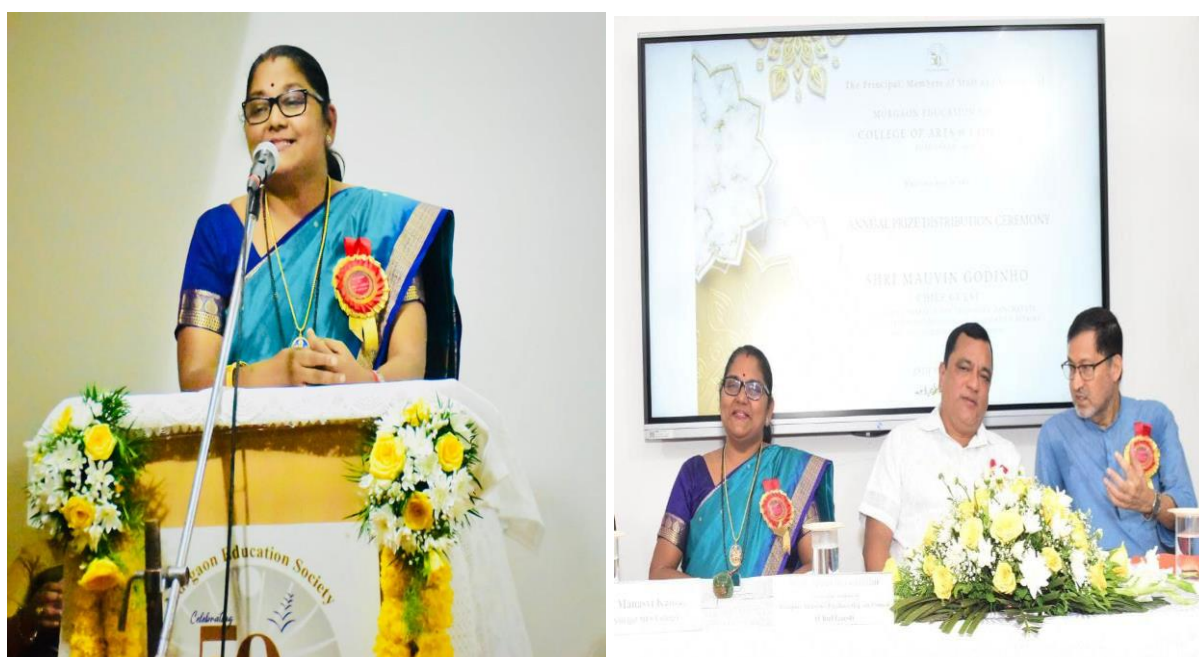


Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony 2022
