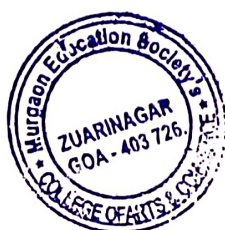

Can also align some good businessmen / entrepreneur for motivational training and insights of running business will definitely help the students to know actual picture of the market. My basic idea is to give them actual picture of the running market and this will definitely enhance the skills of students.

Sessions to be conducted on how to file income tax returns for B. Com students. If possible a small period internship to be introduced for students in various industries/companies for practical experience which would help in their future career. Case studies if introduced would help the students in tackling management problems.
