1. Visit to Atal Adarsh Gram Netravali and interaction with Deputy Sarpanch



A group of 35 students from the Department of Political Science, M.E.S. College Zuarinagar-Goa visited Atal Adarsh Gram (Ideal village) Netravali on 29th May 2022 to understand the functioning of the Panchayati Raj System.

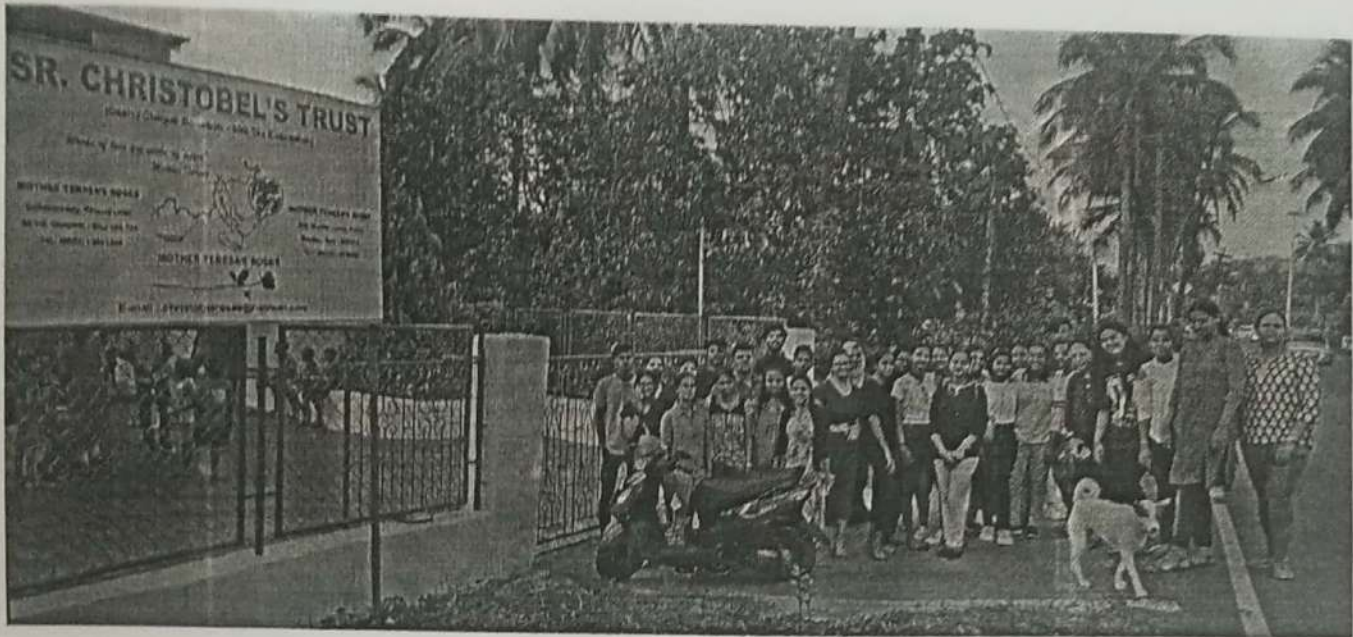
2. Visit to Old age Home
