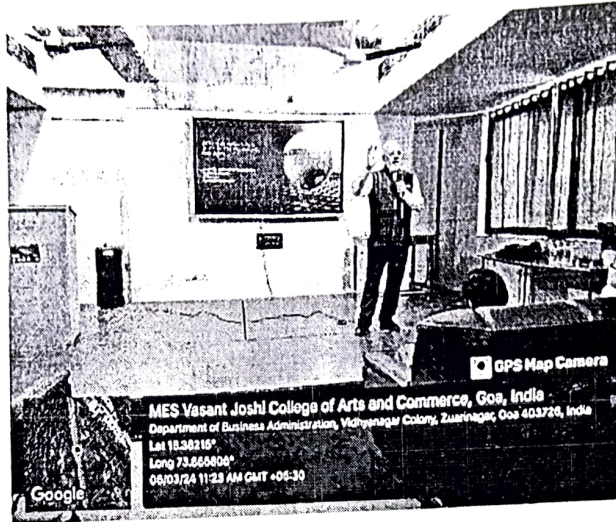
Report in brief:

Department of Business Administration, M.E.S. Vasant Joshi College of Arts & Commerce in association with Goa Management Association organized a session on the topic “Will AI transform the Supply Chain?” as part of the MOU signed between the two institutions. The Resource person of the session was **Mr. Vasu Ramanujam, Partner- Growth & Strategy, KoiReader Inc.**

Objective: The objective of the session was to make students aware about the transformations brought by AI in Supply Chain.

The programme commenced with the introduction of the Resource person by Ms. Anushree Belgal. The Resource person, Mr. Ramanujam started the session by explaining various branches of Artificial Intelligence, such as Natural Language Processing, Machine Vision, Robotics, and Machine Learning. Subsequently, he delved into the fundamental concepts of supply chain management, placing particular emphasis on the application of AI in warehouse management.

During the discussion, Mr. Ramanujam highlighted the role of AI in warehouse operations, citing examples of how machine vision is employed to monitor the loading and unloading of goods at warehouse docks. He elaborated on the use of technologies like Robots, Automated Guided Vehicles, Drones, and their importance to warehouse efficiency and safety. The resource person underscored how AI implementation has notably reduced accidents in warehouses.




At the end of the session there was a question and answer session. The students asked questions and the resource person answered reflecting upon his wealth of expertise.

The session ended with a vote of thanks given by Ms. Meezyat Shaik. The comparing was done by Ms. Khushi Barman. Dr. Kirti Tyagi, Programme Co-ordinator – BBA presented the memento to the Resource person. The program was coordinated by Asst. Prof. Mr. Paricshit Phal Desai, MOU Co-ordinator.
