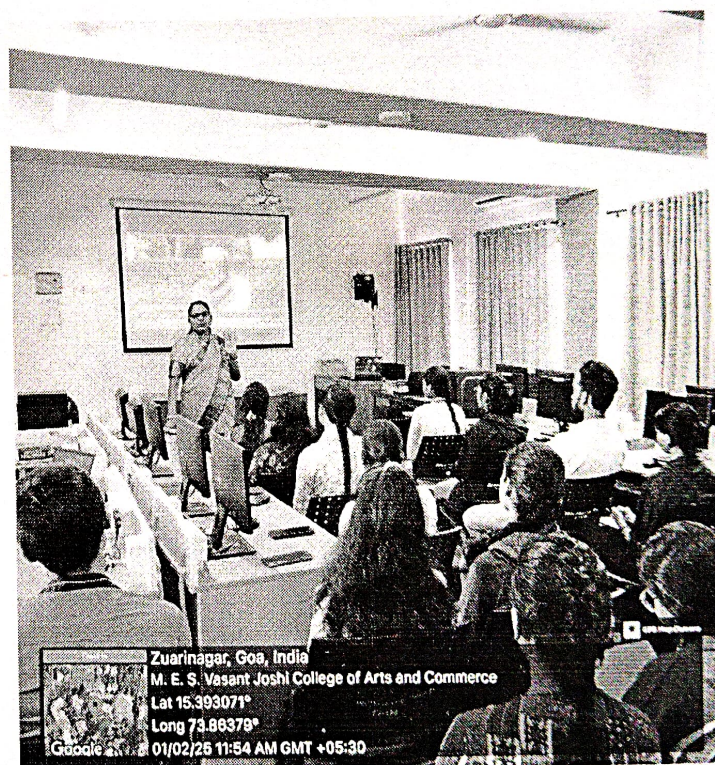
During the session, students were encouraged to take down key points and observations from the live screening to facilitate a deeper understanding of the budget announcements.
