• Report in brief:

The Department of Commerce and IQAC at M.E.S. Vasant Joshi College of Arts & Commerce successfully organized an Investor Awareness Program in association with Empirical F&M Academy on 3rd March 2025 in room no. 05, 04 and 31 at 9:15 am, 10:15 am and 11:3 am respectively. The program was designed to equip students with essential financial knowledge, focusing on: Financial Planning, Mutual Funds and Ongoing Fraud Awareness.

The sessions were scheduled for different batches that includes F.Y.B.COM (Div- A, B & C), S.Y.B.COM (Div- A & B) and T.Y.B.COM (Div- C & D). The session was conducted by Mr. Vikas Vishwakarma, a BFM-certified trading professional with expertise in Advance Technical Analysis, Agri Commodity Trading, and currently pursuing CMT. Mr. Vishwakarma not only provided theoretical knowledge but also conducted a practical demonstration on reading various candle patterns in trading. He explained different types of candles used in technical analysis and their significance in predicting market trends. The students actively participated in the session, gaining hands-on knowledge about market movements and investment strategies. The event was efficiently coordinated by Assistant Prof. Sanjana Halankar (Event Coordinator). In Total 146 (Males- 51 and Females - 95) students attended the session.
