Report on One Day Workshop "Outcome-Based Education: A Pathway to Excellence" 7th February 2025

Developing rubrics for effective assessment of learning outcomes. Creating a matrix to systematically map COs to POs and PSOs for accreditation and quality assurance. Hands-on exercises to practice mapping and evaluating outcomes.

59 (Male-19 & Female-40) Faculty members actively participated in discussions and exercises, gaining practical knowledge on structuring assessments to enhance student learning and institutional accreditation processes. The interactive nature of the workshop encouraged the exchange of ideas, making the session highly productive and insightful.
