



# REPORT OF THE VALUE EDUCATION CELL ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

The Value Education Cell of M.E.S College of Arts and Commerce, organized an online Photography Competition on the topic **'The Thing I Value the Most and Why'** for the students of B.A, B.Com, B.C.A, B.B.A, M.Com programmes from 4<sup>th</sup> February 2022 onwards. The last day for receiving entries was 12<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

The judging criteria for the competition was clarity of expression, visual design and overall artistic presentation, each criteria having ten points and a cumulative of thirty points. Twenty students registered for the competition via google form link from all the programmes, out of which nine entries were received for participation.

The rules of the photography competition were as follows:

- Students of B.A, B.COM., B.C.A, B.B.A and M.COM streams are eligible to participate.
- > Only one entry per student is allowed.
- > Photograph should be clicked by the participant using a mobile phone only.
- > Photograph to be uploaded in JPEG format.
- > Description of the picture in required (upto 200 words).
- > Basic editing (colour enhancement, filters, cropping) is allowed.
- Advanced editing (to create illusion, or manipulations) is not allowed.
- > Photos which include offensive content will be discarded.
