- The **Value Education Cell** in association with the NSS Unit of the college organized a workshop on '**Professional Ethics at the Workplace**' held on 13th October 2022 in the M.S. Kamat Seminar Hall of the college at 12.35 p.m. Mr. Deependra Chumble was invited as the resource person. Mr. Chumble is an independent HR Consultant working with a variety of clients across different industries and brings with him a vast leadership and multi-cultural experience of over 30 years in Human Resources function with in-depth industry knowledge of hotels, banking, IT and ITES.
- The program began with a welcome address by Mr. Dattaprasad Shirgurkar, the NSS Programme officer and in-charge who emphasized the importance of ethics at the workplace. Dr. Sancheliana Faria introduced the speaker and presented floral welcome to the resource person. The resource person felt that education laid the foundation for ethics. He also examined the difference between morals, values and ethics, with morals referring to individual beliefs, values dealing with personal qualities and ethics which is the manifestation of what a person is. The speaker stressed on communication, as being very important wherein one needs to speak to the point to avoid being misinterpreted or misunderstood. He also emphasized the importance of teamwork and networking which can enhance team building. Mr. Deependra Chumble also felt that empathy was very essential at the workplace. Similarly, he was of the opinion that connectivity is important and a certain level of responsibility was also required to be made a priority. He also believed that one should participate and take ownership of oneself and the organization, taking initiative was also stressed, respecting the diversity at the workplace could truly lead to success at the workplace. The workshop gave a deep insight into the finer things that were important and how ensuring financial ethics was also necessary to maintain integrity in an organization. Ms. Neha Dhuri a student from TYBCOM presented feedback of the session. At the end of the function, the Principal Dr. Manasvi Kamat presented a potted plant to the resource person as a token of our love and appreciation. Ms. Cedila Pereira e Gomes, the event coordinator and member of the Value Education Cell proposed the vote of thanks. 68 students participated in the program.
